## Turkish Society of Toxicology -European Registered Toxicologist **Evaluation Form**

Education, scientific activity, and professional recognition of applicants are evaluated by correlating defined criteria with a corresponding point system. A minimum number of points must be attained in each area. The total of 70 points out of 100, with the minimum in each area (1. Education, 2. Scientific Activity and 3. Professional recognition) being met, are required for the Turkish Society of Toxicology -European Registered Toxicologist. Maximum and minimum points of each area are as follows
